St. Andrew's seeks a motivated, self-starting and energetic personality to help form our children, youth, and their families in the Episcopal faith. The Director of Family Ministries creates weekly intergenerational worship and learning experiences for children and families as well as fellowship opportunities for special occasions. The DFM is also a teacher, leading and training others to lead the Sunday Family Service, and empowering our children and youth to be engaged and fully integrated into the life of the parish.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan and lead weekly Family Service of the Word, including selecting appropriate music and themes (Pre-K through 5th grade)
- Plan and lead quarterly youth events, such as outreach projects, social gatherings, and spiritual formation (6th through 12th grade)
- Provide families with relevant prayer resources and activities to be used at home
- Work collaboratively with parish staff and lay volunteers to develop and implement a cohesive strategy for Family Ministries

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- A passion for ministry to children and youth and an ability to engage their parents and family members
- Creativity, a sense of humor, and a willingness to experiment and explore new ideas
- Facility with utilizing digital ministry resources
- Bachelor's degree preferred
