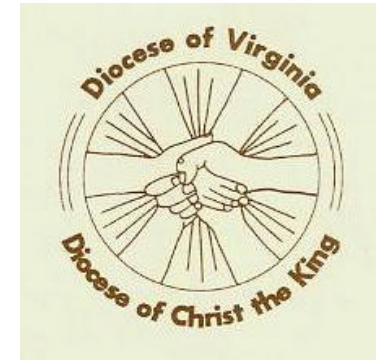

Our Presenter

The Rev. Martha Macgill moved from Virginia with her husband and two children in order to serve as Priest-in-Charge of St. Francis Anglican Church in the Diocese of Christ the King, South Africa. From November 1997 to July 2000 this family lived among the people and shared in their ways as they also brought to action God's grace in a far away place. Currently, the Rev. Mrs. Macgill is on a 4-month sabbatical to write a book about what it meant to accept this call to mission and how this experience continues to influence all that she does and is. She presently serves as Rector, Memorial Episcopal Church, Baltimore, Maryland
