Biographical Sketch:

I am Kimberly Baker Glenn, Rector at Grace Episcopal Church, Kilmarnock, VA. I have a dual degree in Christian Education (2005) and Masters of Divinity from Union Presbyterian Seminary (2013) in Richmond, VA and a Diploma in Anglican Studies from VTS (2015). I was ordained to the priesthood in December 2015 and served for four years in the Diocese of Southwestern Virginia. I was appointed by Bishop Mark Bourlakas to serve on the Commission on Ministry. In 2019, I received a call to become rector of Grace Church, Kilmarnock. I have recently been appointed by Bishop Goff to serve on the Committee on Constitutions and Canons. Previously, while serving as lay Youth Minister at St. Mary's in Goochland between 2000 and 2009, I served in this Diocese as chair of the Diocesan Commission for Youth.

I would like to serve on the Standing Committee as faithful counsel to the Bishop in matters concerning real property and especially in matters concerning reviews and recommendations of people seeking Candidacy for ordination. I believe the Diocese is most successful when committees are representative of all regions of the Diocese.
