From 1981-1992, I was employed in corporate Banking with a specialty in commercial real estate finance at Chemical Bank of New York, Bank of Virginia and First Union National Bank of North Carolina. As a regional manager at First Union, I managed a \$500 million commercial real estate loan portfolio and a staff of six.

From 1992-2006 while raising my three sons, I worked as a part-time business consultant and volunteer in a wide variety of non-profit organizations. I have served as the President of the Junior League of Richmond, Chairman of the Board of the Carver Promise, Chair of Community Organization and Housing on the board of the Urban League of Greater Richmond, Chairman of Agents for the Yale Alumni Fund, President of the Yale Club of Virginia, and am a graduate of Leadership Metro Richmond.

Church Involvement – Local, Diocesan, National

Since my ordination to the Priesthood in 2011, I have served on the Executive Board of the Diocese of Virginia from 2013-2015 and am currently a member of the Editorial Review Board of the *Interpretation* Journal of Biblical Scholarship. I also serve on the board of Belltower Productions, a faith-based filmmaking initiative.

I have served as the Vicar of All Souls, Mechanicsville since January 2012. All Souls is a mission church of the Diocese and one of our three remaining church plants. Previous to coming to All Souls, I worked as a transitional deacon at St. John's Church and St. Mary's Goochland, and as a chaplain at Westminster-Canterbury. While in seminary, I served as an intern at Christ Ascension Episcopal Church, Richmond, and St. Thomas', Richmond. She also served as a chaplain at Johnston-Willis hospital.

A lifelong Episcopalian, I have served as a Lay Reader, Eucharistic Minister, Sunday school teacher, Adult Forum Leader, and have assisted with Youth Group, Community Outreach, Fellowship and Lent Program ministries. I am a graduate of Education for Ministry (EfM) and Disciples of Christ in Community (DOCC).
