**AGREED INITIAL SCHEDULING ORDER
ON REVIEW OF RESPONDENT’S REQUEST FOR REVIEW
OF MINISTRY RESTRICTIONS (PASTORAL DIRECTION)**

May 27, 2021

Respondent having requested, pursuant to Canon IV.7.10, review of the imposition of ministry restrictions and terms and conditions thereof set forth in the Pastoral Direction issued by letter to her dated October 24, 2019, from the Rt. Rev. Susan E. Goff, the Suffragan Bishop and Ecclesiastical Authority of the Diocese of Virginia; and

The Church Attorney, on behalf of the Diocese, having moved to dismiss Respondent’s Request for alleged lack of jurisdiction; and

The parties, through their representatives, having agreed to submit briefs in support of their respective positions prior to a hearing on the Request;

The Hearing Panel hereby ORDERS as follows:

- On or before **Thursday, June 3, 2021**, the Church Attorney shall submit his opening brief to the three members of the Hearing Panel, with copies to its counsel, to counsel for the Respondent, and to her Advisor.
- On or before **Thursday, June 17**, Respondent by counsel shall submit her responsive brief in a similar manner.
- On or before **Monday, June 28**, the Church Attorney shall submit his reply brief in a similar manner.

- Concurrently the Hearing Panel, through its President and in conjunction with the party representatives, will seek to schedule a recorded hearing by Zoom at the earliest feasible date following submission of the Church Attorney’s reply brief.
- All submissions are to be by email, and electronic signatures will be acceptable (such as /s/ [Name]).
- In the interest of avoiding unnecessary delay, and after completion of the briefing schedule set forth above, the parties through their representatives are directed to work with one another to prepare for submission additional Agreed Scheduling Orders, contingent on the outcome of the pending jurisdictional motion, to provide for briefing and argument on the substance of the Request for Review, and to provide for discovery, hearing, and related procedures (which may include extensions of Canon-imposed deadlines) pertaining to Respondent’s Response to Hearing Panel’s Notice Dated March 24, 2021, and to the allegations that Respondent has violated the Canons of the Diocese and of the Episcopal Church.
