

Prayer Graphic Workbook

This is an easy way to create prayer graphics without needing photoshop. There are three pre-created text fields – one clear, one tinted black, one tinted white.

For those unfamiliar with Powerpoint, the next slide will have step-by-step directions to make this simple and easy. These are create to use as images on Facebook for Sunday worship links.

You simply need:

- (1) A picture of your church (or whatever background you want)*
- (2) A prayer/collect... easily found online*
- (3) If you wish, your church's logo*

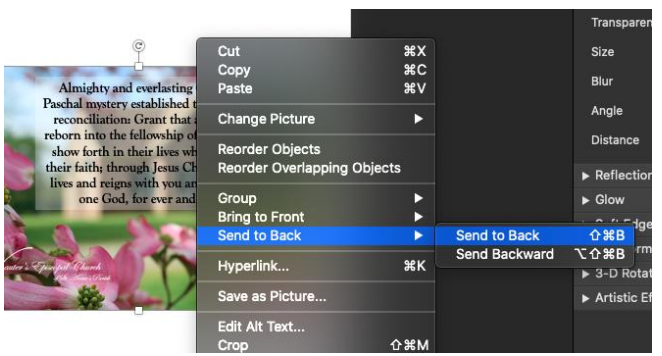


Each of the graphics on the next three slides has an appropriate background to the text so that you can read it, no matter what the background image looks like. You can decide which works best.

Go to which slide that has the text background that you want. Then, at the top of the screen, where the drop downs are, you click "Insert" → "Picture" → "Picture from File."

Once the image is on the screen, you delete out the picture of my church. You'll do the same for your logo, if you choose to include it.

Then, right click on the image of the church, and then select "Send to Back" → "Send to Back." This should make the text box appear on top of the image.



You then drop whatever prayer you want into the text box. Set the font to whatever color works best (I'd recommend either black or white) and whatever style you want.


You then click and drag your mouse to highlight the image, prayer, and logo. White boxes should appear around each of the components. You then click "Save a Picture." Title it, and save it!


