

## Triangle of Hope report

The projects in the Triangle of Hope are beginning again post-COVID. Our partners in Kumasi and Liverpool are both getting teams together for the resumption of the Youth Pilgrimage in the summer of 2023 to Liverpool.

We have done well maintaining the links between leadership, mostly through online communications, but we did have a board meeting in coordination with Bishop Paul Bayes (Liverpool) final service. We established to have a yearly gathering of leadership to further expand our work.

The Youth Pilgrimage is currently receiving applications for team members, and the applications close on December 1. It is a rolling acceptance, so we encourage those interested to apply sooner rather than later. There are 14 spots on the team to fill.

We are working on partnerships amongst our seminaries to enable those in formation to the clergy to have training and experience with these conversations. We are looking at connecting the ECW with the Mothers Union in Liverpool and Kumasi. Lastly, conversations are in the first stages of having parish triangles formed connecting a church with sister churches in the other two dioceses.

Lastly, our work has been bolstered by the Rev. Lee Hill to the diocesan staff and we are thankful for his leadership and increasing participation.
