Nina Janopaul has been President/CEO of the Arlington Partnership for Affordable Housing, a non-profit, community-based, award winning, affordable housing developer, since 2007. APAH has a portfolio of fifteen multifamily rental properties with 1340 units, valued at almost \$300 million with another 650 units in development. APAH has received numerous awards, including the Charles Edson award for best urban development in the country; the Urban Land Institute—DC's best Housing project; Developer of the Year from the Housing Association of Non-Profit Developers; Best Nonprofit by the Arlington Chamber of Commerce and the Arlington Community Foundation's Prize for Impact and Innovation. APAH is known for its nimble and effective real estate development, for pioneering innovative supportive housing partnerships and green building. Prior to joining APAH, Ms. Janopaul was a principal at Capital Strategies Consulting, Inc. providing services to a variety of organizations, including Enterprise Community Partners. Prior to 2000, she was the National Director of Development for Hostelling International – USA (formerly American Youth Hostels). Ms. Janopaul received a Bachelor of Arts Magna Cum Laude from Harvard University. She serves on the Virginia Housing Development Authority's Northern Virginia Advisory Committee; Arlington's Ten Year Plan to End Homelessness; the Community Energy and Sustainability Task Force and the Arlington School Health Advisory Board. She is a past President of HAND, a regional housing association and received the Virginia Housing Coalition's 2013 Innovations in Leadership award.
